

## **Golden Beeches Weekend at Stokenchurch, Bucks 23/24 October 2010**

### **Accommodation for visitors**

Places are listed in order of nearness to Longburrow Hall, Stokenchurch. The figure in brackets is the approximate distance away, in miles, some of which may be hilly! You're advised to check locations on a map: OS Landrangers 165 and 175, which will also cover the rides.

Accommodation in Bucks and the Chilterns is not cheap. However most of the places on this list provide b&b for two, in a double or twin room, for around £60 or less; singles are generally £30+.

**Camping**

We are able – as in 2005 and 2009 – to accommodate **up to 6 self-contained motorhomes** overnight on the hall car park, Saturday night only, **with no access to hall facilities between 10pm Saturday and 9am Sunday**. Please contact us if you would like to reserve a space.

For tents, caravans and motorhomes, **Home Farm at Radnage** (formerly known as Karma Farm) is in a pleasant location, access next to the Crown PH. (grid ref 783967 on OS 165, 2 miles from Stokenchurch). Showers and toilets, electric hook-ups. For more information 'phone 01494 484136.

**White Mark Farm at Watlington** is 6+ miles from base (grid ref 696938 on OS 175). I have heard very favourable reports of it. Good but simple facilities (including toilets, showers and wash-basins) but no electric hook-ups. Phone 01491 612295 for information.

***Please note, there are very few camp sites in the Chilterns and both of these sites are likely to be busy at weekends - you definitely need to book well in advance!***
