

Booking information for CTC South Bucks DA's

Golden Beeches Weekend, 25-26 October 2008

Event HQ Longburrow Hall, Park Lane, Stokenchurch, nr High Wycombe, Bucks HP14 3TQ
(off A40, grid ref 761965 on OS map 165, under a mile from M40 Junction 5)

Programme

Saturday **Hall open from 9.30am:** register arrival, collect tickets for meals, hall refreshments and slide show; tea/coffee and cake before your ride. **'Park Cycles' will be at the hall for spares and repairs.**

Rides – led groups leave at 10.00am –

Short (29 miles) to the Thames at Benson

Medium (43) Henley-on-Thames and Chiltern Villages

Longer (64) Windsor Great Park and the Thames

Back at the hall – tea and biscuits

A quiz to complete at your leisure

Evening meal Jacket spud with a choice of fillings, hot and cold, salad buffet, followed by selection of desserts with custard or cream, plus tea or coffee, **available any time between 5 and 6pm.**

7.45pm – slide show 'A Little Bit of Oz' by Mac Crombie

Sunday **Hall open from 9.00am:** new arrivals to register, tea/coffee and cakes before ride

Rides – Led groups leave at 9.30am (note, clocks have 'gone back' overnight!)

Short (26 miles) to Hambleden and Henley-on-Thames

Medium (45 miles) to the Vale and Hilltop Villages

Longer (49 miles) a challenging hilly ride through the south-west Chilterns

Off-road – a informal ride on scenic Chiltern bridleways with an experienced local leader (*you will need to carry adequate food and drink*)

Back at the hall – tea/coffee/squash after your ride if you wish

Late lunch 'Posh Ploughmans': crusty bread or roll with a selection of cheeses and cold meats, pickles, chutneys and salads, followed by fruit crumble or fruit salad with custard or cream, plus tea or coffee, **available any time between 2 and 3pm**

There is no bar, but you are welcome to bring a bottle of wine to enjoy with your meal.

Please note that if you'd like vegetarian meals this must be clearly shown on the booking form!

Refreshments on short, medium and longer rides will be available at cafes, garden centres and pubs along the routes. There's no need to book but if you indicate which rides you're *likely* to take part in we can advise – beforehand – the catering establishments likely to be most used. **If you prefer to take a picnic**, there are two shops in Stokenchurch to supply your needs.

Please keep this sheet for information, and return the booking form with a stamped addressed A5 envelope for detailed route instructions, list of cafes etc and – importantly! – how to find the hall and where to park. **Closing date for bookings, 11 October.**
